Happy Birthday to Father Kelvin Maloney

On February 2nd, 77 years ago, a baby boy was born to Ambrose and Isabella (Leafy MacMillan) Maloney of St. Andrews West. That baby would grow up to be the Reverend Kelvin Maloney. (And of course he is the younger brother of Father George Maloney, another faithful servant of the diocese.)

Father Kelvin studied philosophy at the Séminaire de Philosophie in Montreal. He then began his theology studies at the Grand Séminaire de Saint-Sulpice in Montreal. On Pentecost Sunday, June 2, 1963, he was ordained to the priesthood at the parish of St. Andrew by the Most

Reverend Jacques Landriault.


Since his ordination Father Kelvin has served many of our parishes including the Cocathédrale de la Nativité (his first appointment as assistant pastor), St. Columban, St. Francis de Sales, Holy Cross, St. Peter (where he was the founding pastor in 1978) and Blessed Sacrament. Since 1998, he has been rector of St. Finnan Cathedral in Alexandria and pastor of St. Catherine of Sienna in Greenfield.

During his many years with the diocese he has been involved in a variety of pro-

jects including being employed by the Tri-Counties Separate School Board as Director of Religious Education. He has also served as Vicar-General under our last three bishops. Among our active priests, Father Kelvin is the diocese's longest serving priest with 52 years of service.

Because of space, the above is only the tiniest of snippets of what Father Kelvin has done and meant to this diocese. On this his 77th birthday we wish him much joy and we ask the Lord to bless him with good health for many years to come.
