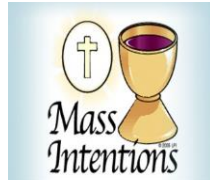

Joe married Sandra in 1971. He was an addictions counsellor at the Donwood Institute in Toronto and founder of Rideauwood Institute in Ottawa. He was a police chaplain for many years. He loved the farm and cherished the land until the day he died.
