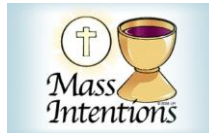

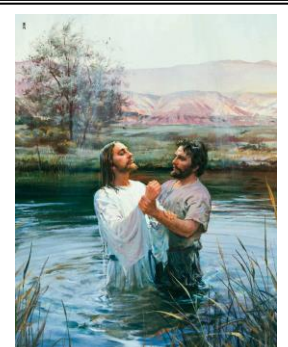
1st Holy Eucharist

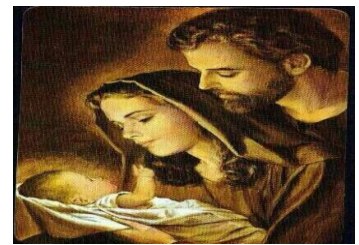
Called and Gifted Introductory Workshop on Saturday, February 24th 2018
