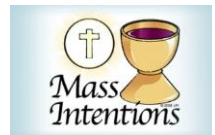
1st Sunday of Lent

The Test: After his baptism, Jesus was driven into the desert by the Spirit so he could be tested. Unlike Matthew's and Luke's gospels, Mark did not explain the temptation. Instead, he used it as a transition between the baptism and the ministry of Jesus. Mark would return to the solitude of Jesus again and again to stress the prayer life of the Master.

GOSPEL: The Temptation of Jesus in the desert is almost non-existent in Mark's gospel. Unlike the three temptations found in Luke and Matthew, the Temptation consisted of a single verse. But we should not overlook that verse. It acts as transition to the theme the Baptist's and Christ's preaching.
