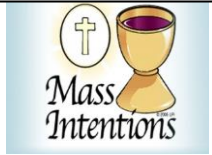


The End of Days

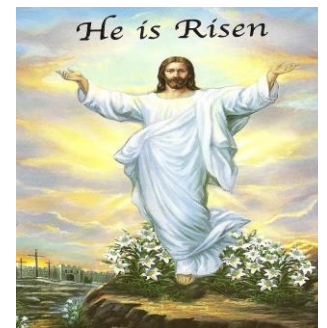
