COMMUNITY

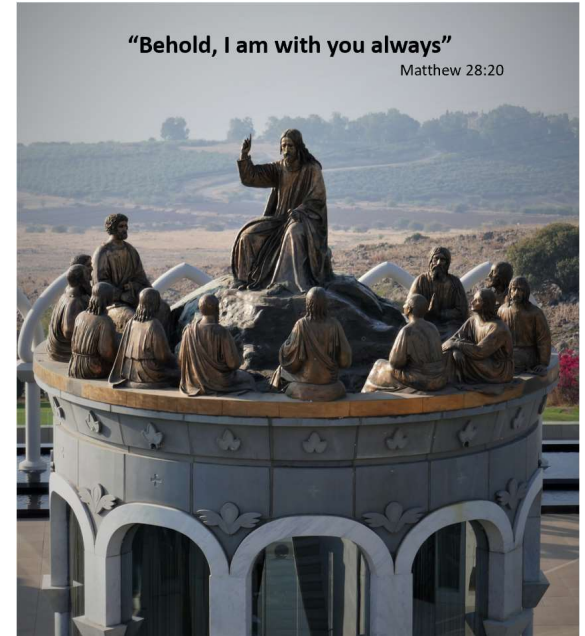
Let us realize that we are all members of the Body of Christ.
