We expect for them to keep reading, thinking, and growing by participating in **NA's Summer Reading Requirement Challenge**. The public library is a great resource to use for this challenge.

All your student has to do is meet the summer reading genre requirements and keep a reading log. Your child's teacher has prepared activities/projects that will be completed **in class** during the first few weeks of school. The assignments/projects will be for 3 different genres. Students will be asked to bring a copy of the book to school to complete tasks. If the student does not have a personal copy, we will assist students in obtaining a copy either from our library or the public library. Summer reading requirements should be completed **before the start of school**.

Every child who completes the summer reading challenge requirements and returns it to school at the beginning of the new school year will receive a treat! All grades from the in-class summer reading assignments/projects will count as **test grades**.
