Reading I Acts 10:34, 37-43 (Peter's discourse)

Reading II Colossians 3: 1-4 (mystical death and resurrection) or
1 Corinthians 5:6-8 (the yeast of sincerity and truth)

Gospel John 20:1-9 (Peter and the disciple at the tomb)



Key Passage Clean out the old yeast so that you may be a new batch, as you really are unleavened. For our paschal lamb, Christ has been sacrificed. (1 Corinthians 5:7)

Question of the Week: What change does the hope of Christ's resurrection inspire you to make?

Living as a disciple: In prayer and reflection, discern what bad habit you would like to "clear out" during the hopeful time of this Easter season, and with God's help begin to work on getting ride of this bad habit and replace it with an opposite positive virtue.
