### Day 1: Thursday, June 20

#### DEPART PHOENIX

This morning, departure is scheduled from the Cathedral of Ss. Simon and Jude. The group will depart Phoenix and head west toward Los Angeles, California. Stop in the Palm Springs area to celebrate Mass at Our Lady of Solitude (Missionaries of the Sacred Heart, M.S.C) and lunch on your own. Then, visit Tahquitz Falls to see the 60ft. waterfall. Continue on to Los Angeles and upon arrival check into your hotel. Enjoy a Welcome Dinner and overnight in Los Angeles. ( D )

### Day 2: Friday, June 21

#### CATHEDRAL OF OUR LADY OF THE ANGELS | CARMEL OF ST. TERESA MONASTERY MISSION SAN GABRIEL ARCÁNGEL | WINE TASTING

After breakfast, transfer to the Cathedral of Our Lady of the Angels, the mother church of the Archdiocese of Los Angeles, to celebrate Mass followed by a guided tour. Time for lunch on your own in the Pasadena area. In the afternoon, visit and tour the Carmel of St. Teresa Monastery and Mission San Gabriel Arcángel, founded by St. Junipero Serra, as the fourth of the twenty one California Missions. Learn the history of these sites and the role each have played in the state's history. Then, experience a special Californian wine tasting! Evening of leisure with dinner on own. Overnight in Los Angeles. ( B | WT )

### Day 3: Saturday, June 22

#### CHRIST CATHEDRAL | MISSION SAN JUAN CAPISTRANO

After breakfast, check out of the hotel and depart to Christ (Crystal) Cathedral, which was the largest glass building in the world when it was completed in 1981. It also has one of the largest musical instruments in the world, the Hazel Wright Memorial Organ. Celebrate Mass followed by a guided tour and time for prayer. Depart to Los Rios Street, the oldest Street in California, for lunch on your own and time for shopping. Then, visit Mission San Juan Capistrano, founded in 1776 featuring the Serra Chapel, the only standing church where Saint Serra is known to have said Mass. Participate in a guided tour of the Mission followed by time to pray in the peaceful and stunning gardens or explore the museum housing one-of-a kind artifacts, treasures and paintings. Check into your hotel in Mission Viejo and freshen up before departing toward the coast. Enjoy time at leisure on the coastline, shop and relax before a farewell dinner. Return to your hotel for an overnight in Mission Viejo. ( B | D )

### Day 4: Sunday, June 23

#### RETURN

After breakfast, check out of hotel and begin the journey back to Phoenix. Stop for lunch along the way. Celebrate Mass at Our Lady of Solitude Monastery and meet the Poor Clares of Perpetual Adoration (Desert Nuns) before completing the final leg of the pilgrimage. Return to Ss. Simon & Jude Cathedral. ( B )
