SCRIP IS BACK!!! Scrip will be sold after the weekend Masses at St. Leo's starting next weekend, Jan. 23rd & 24th. Scrip is using gift cards to pay for your purchases. We have gift cards for groceries, gas, household items, clothing, building & remodeling, dining out and as gifts. There are about 90 local businesses who participate in the Bishop Ryan Scrip Program. The school and BR families earn a percentage of every purchase you make using Scrip. This is a great way to support Bishop Ryan without spending any extra money. You get the same dollar amount in gift cards that you pay for; the profit for us comes in the rebate that the business allows us on your purchase. So the more you use in gift cards, the more we earn! Using gift cards protects you from credit card fraud, which is becoming more common every day. You're already shopping for groceries, gas, household items, dining out, (and the list goes on) so why not use Scrip? (Scrip will not be available weekdays at St. Leo's Parish office.) If you don't know a family to give credit to, we have a "Needy Fund" you can credit your purchase to. If you're a parent of young children who you'd like to send to Bishop Ryan someday, you can call Elaine @ the BR office (838-3355) to set up an account, and you can use Scrip & start building credit for your child's tuition. Grandparents can build an account for grandkids too, just set up the account first.

Registration for Little Lions Preschool for 2016-17 at Bishop Ryan is now open! Half-day classes (morning or afternoon) meet two days, three days or five days a week starting in August, and this year, we're introducing a full-day five-day class. To register, children must be bathroom-trained and three years old by July 31, 2016 for the two-day and three-day classes or four years old by July 31, 2016 for the five-day classes.
