



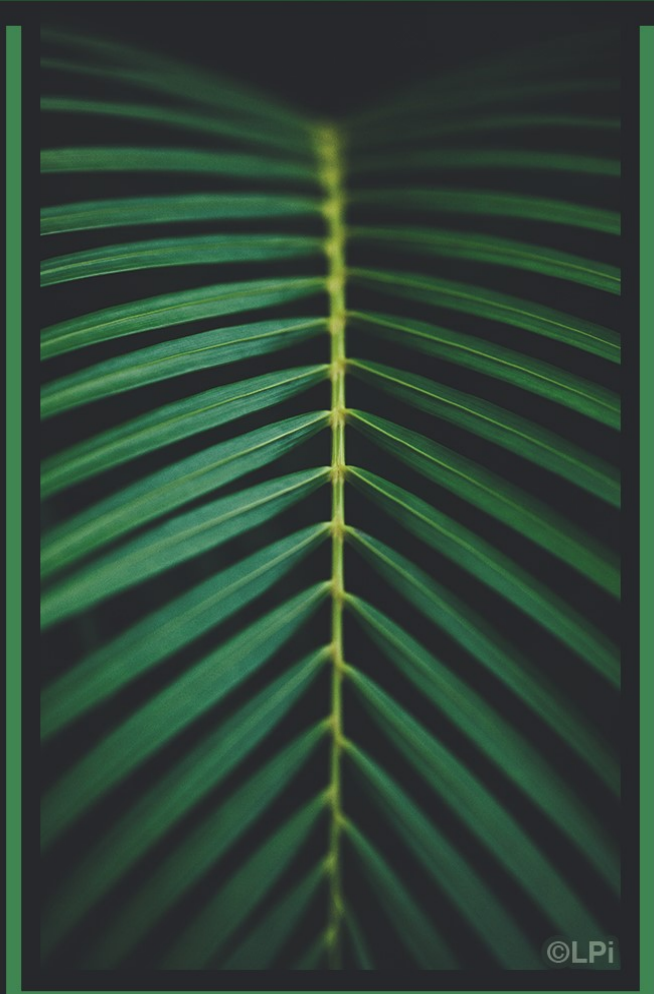

MEETING SCHEDULED FOR 2020 EASTERN EUROPE/PASSION PLAY TRIP

An informal meeting will be held in the gathering space at **Little Flower Church, Monday, April 15th beginning at 6:30 pm** for anyone interested in the trip to Europe to see the Passion Play in 2020. Registration brochures and forms will be on hand for those who would like to sign up and reserve their spot for the trip. The dates for the trip are June 17-27, 2020, and the total cost of the trip is \$4,899. A down payment of \$800 and a copy of your passport will be required at the time of registration (copies can be made that night).
