In 1930, Fr. A.G. Sertillanges published the life and teachings of St. Thomas Aquinas in his native French. We have an updated 2011 translation by Fr. Godfrey Anstruther, another Benedictine: *Thomas Aquinas: Scholar, poet, mystic, saint*. The book places St. Thomas in his time, as the church came to grips with Aristotle.
