

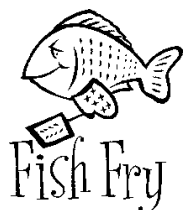
A Note from the Pastor

Baptismal Preparation Classes

Next Class: April 27 @ 11 - Parish Hall

To baptize, you must live within the parish boundary and should be attending Mass. If from another parish (immediate family [i.e., parents or grandparents] are active parishioners) you must provide a letter from your pastor stating you are active and you must attend your parish's baptismal class. Baptisms are held the first Sunday of each month, after the 9:00 a.m. Mass, except during the seasons of Advent and Lent, or otherwise noted. Birth certificate of child is required before baptism.
