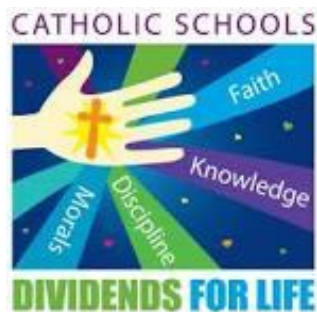
FIRST FRIDAY STATIONS OF THE CROSS
