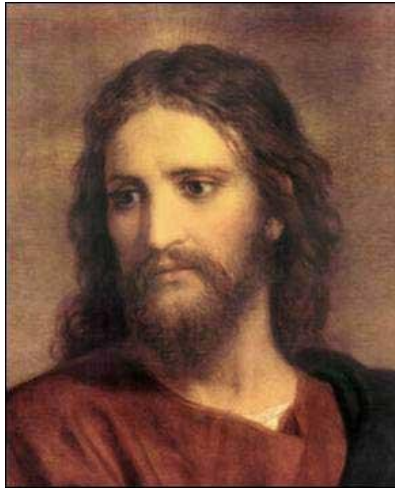

FINANCE REPORT

For the past 15 years, the parish has been making payments on a loan with Suntrust Bank for the construction of the school and social hall. The final payment was made in March of this year. We have also been paying the interest only on a second loan with the Nashville Diocese. Recently a payment of \$250,000 was paid on this loan leaving a balance of \$83,000. The diocese has agreed that if the loan is paid in full within 15 months that no interest will be charged. If you would like to donate to this final debt, please mark your check as "Debt Reduction", or use the Debt Reduction envelope.
