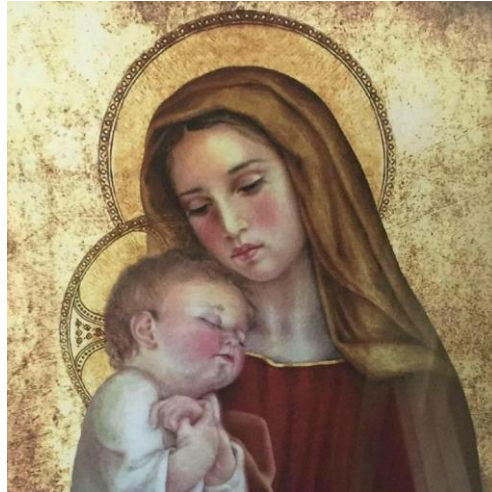

The second is **All Souls Day** on **November 2,** in which the Church offers Mass for the repose of the souls in Purgatory. **Mass will be celebrated on Thursday, November 2, at 10:30 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.**

A **plenary indulgence** may be granted for a soul in **Purgatory** if one **visits a church on All Souls' Day and recites the Our Father and the Creed or visits a cemetery and prays for the departed on any day from November 1 to November 8.** The usual conditions for a plenary indulgence apply.
