## CONFIRMATION CLASSES

The Sacrament of Confirmation continues the work begun at Baptism by bringing an increase and deepening of baptismal grace to our lives. In this Sacrament, we become more perfectly united to the Church and receive special grace from the Holy Spirit, which enables us to better live out our Faith as true witnesses of Christ's love and presence

**St. John Vianney offers a two-year preparation program for the Sacrament of Confirmation.** At our parish, this typically takes place during the 7th and 8th grade years, though some older students who have not yet received the Sacrament of Confirmation, may participate in this preparation program.

The first year of Confirmation Preparation involves lessons aimed at providing a basis for understanding the faith and kindling a love of God, the Church, and others in each student.

The second year of Confirmation Preparation invites students to consider what it means to be a follower of Jesus Christ and how their lives should reflect their faith.

**Registration for Confirmation Classes will be held on Sunday, July 29**, between the Masses and is open to all registered parishioners. Faithful weekend Mass attendance is required as preparation to receive the sacrament. Families must be registered and contributing for at least six months. Non-Registered candidates will be placed on a waiting list. A copy of the Baptismal Certificate is required.
