LENTEN RULES require Catholics between the ages of 18 and 60 to fast on Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. In addition all Catholics 14 years of age and older must abstain from meat on Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, and all the Fridays of Lent.

FASTING as explained by the U.S. Conference of Bishops means partaking of only one full meal during the day. Some food (not equaling another full meal) is permitted at breakfast and around midday or in the evening, depending on when a person chooses to eat the main or full meal.

ABSTINENCE forbids the use of meat, but not of eggs, milk products, or condiments made of animal fat.

Stations of the Cross will be held each Friday of Lent at 7:00 p.m. in the Chapel.

LENTEN PENANCE SERVICE

There will be a penance service at St. John Vianney on **Monday, April 1, at 7:00 p.m.** Five priests from other parishes have committed to come and share in the celebration of this Sacrament. All Catholics are obligated to go to Confession at least once a year. This is often referred to as the Easter Duty, because during Lent the faithful prepare themselves spiritually to celebrate the great feast of Easter.

THE GREAT ADVENTURE GIRLS' CLUB
