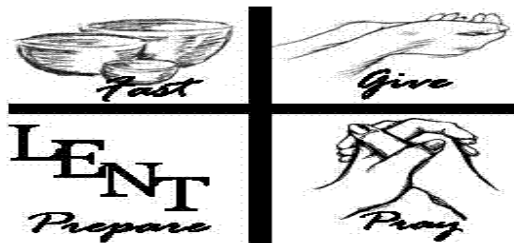
Knights of Columbus Scholarship Announcement
