#### **Here is a breakdown from the last fiscal year:**

(I took the lowest and highest numbers of env. users - shown below. After, I added up 52 weeks of env. users and divided by 52 to get the average number of env. users per week.)

**SM** 89 sets ordered: 37-59 used each week last year with an average of 50 env. users per week last year.

**SJ** 53 sets ordered: 15-42 used each week last year with an average of 32 env. users per week last year.

**CWTR** 117 sets ordered: 40-76 used each week last year with an average of 58 env. users per week last year.

Jer 23:1-6, Eph 2:13-18, Mk 6:30-34

In today's Gospel, Jesus takes the apostles, who are in need of rest, on retreat: to come away by themselves and rest for awhile. Jesus is shepherding them, forming them, so that one day they will be shepherds to the people coming after them. But then he sees the crowds, who are like sheep without a shepherd and begins to teach them as well. Jesus shows us what to do and how to follow. Everyone is called to follow him, to participate in the mission of the Church. Some as apostles. Some as teachers. Some to provide a listening ear or a comforting touch. How are you called to follow? ### Catechism Corner:

Does every person have a vocation? YES! It is to become like Jesus according to their state of life and to participate in the building of the Church. "My vocation is love". How do we do God's will? What is virtue?

We are created with a longing for God. We pray to adore God and praise him for his goodness, to seek his forgiveness for sin, to thank him for our blessings, and to seek his assistance. If we love God, it is only reasonable to talk to him often and always. A prayer can be in any form as long as we are trying to communicate with God who loves us dearly.

God created us to know, love and serve him in this life and to be happy with Him in heaven for all eternity.
