Catechism Corner:

What is the Creed?

It is a prayer that summarizes the essential elements of the Catholic faith. The Apostles' Creed is said at the beginning of the Rosary. The Nicene Creed is usually said at Sunday Mass. We profess what we believe as Catholic Christians.

In this prayer we are reminded of the four marks of our church:

ONE: John 17:11 "Holy Father, keep them in your name that you have given me, so that they may be one just as we are one"

HOLY: When we say that the Church is holy, we mean among other things that she had the all-holy God as her author.

CATHOLIC: Catholic means Universal. It refers as much to the fullness of the faith she possesses, as to the undeniable extension in both to the time and space that has characterized her from the beginning.

APOSTOLIC: The Church began with the commission of Apostles. We can trace our roots to the 12 chosen by Christ. This is our genealogy!
