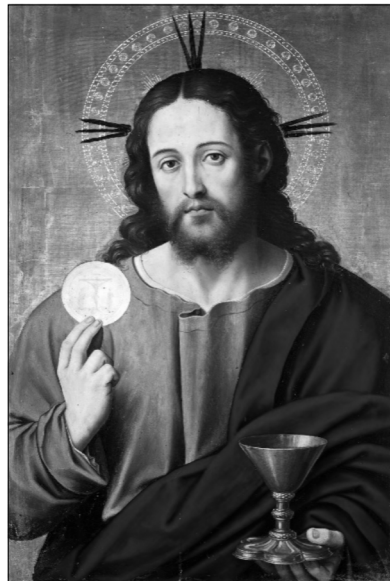

### Catechism Corner:

A **SACRAMENT** is a sign of grace instituted by Christ, entrusted to the Church by which divine life is dispensed to us by the work of the Holy Spirit. Just as He gave (human) life to Jesus and then to the Church, the Holy Spirit brings us divine life.

#### **The Seven Sacraments**

- † **Baptism** (only received once).
- † **Reconciliation** or Confession (please received this often as possible).
- † **Eucharist** or Holy Communion (can be received everyday).
- † **Confirmation** (only received once).
- † **Holy Orders** (only received once, by a man as he becomes a Permanent Deacon or Priest).
- † **Holy Matrimony** or Sacrament of Marriage (holy union between a man and woman).
- † **Anointing of the Sick** (previously called Last Rites), but now we understand that whenever a person is facing a serious illness or dying, this is a wonderful grace and blessing.
