Dt 4:1-2, 6-8 / Jas 1:17-18, 21b-22, 27 / Mk 7:1-8, 14-15, 21-23

You know with some vegetables you eat the leaves and the outside. With an artichoke you got to eat the heart. It's the best bit. The best of religion is in the heart. Religion is of the heart. Jesus today talks a lot about that - lip service and hearts far from him.

The people who were wondering about the bits and pieces were sincere. They kept the law but then were intolerant of weakness in others. They missed often on people's goodness and so they talked of people who didn't wash hands, cups and God knows what else.

The heart is the place of true religion. We say that otherwise too: get to the heart of things - a person has great heart - put your heart into it - their hearts are miles away - for many of us who can't sing, our hearts sing at Mass!

The heart is a dangerous place. The head will always be sensible - let the third world look after itself, after all they are spending on arms, but the heart will be broken by the hunger of the poorest. The head will tell you that you need sleep but your heart will get up to care for a baby or an elderly parent. So the religion of some of Jesus' time was safe - the rules were kept but was there love?

The heart of religion is found in the heart of God. Love - 'when you love, do not say God is in my heart - say I am in the heart of God.

UPDATE: St. Mary's & St. Joseph's Religious Ed. Registration: Change in First Day of Class

Registration for Religious Education has begun in anticipation of the start of this year's program and can be easily completed online at smsj Catholics.com under Faith Formation. Please register your children by August 31 to ensure that we have books and supplies ready for them on the first day of class. The RE class schedule is also on the website.

There has been a change to the announcement that appeared in last week's bulletin. There will not be a Family Breakfast this year. Instead, on the first day of class, September 9, there will be a reception (with coffee and donuts) and parent meeting at St. Mary's Parish Center at 9 a.m. when the children go to their classes. An adult from each family must attend the meeting. We are eager to welcome everyone to the program and discuss the upcoming year, including changes that have been made.
