Is 50:5-9a / Jas 2:14-18 / Mk 8:27-35

Do we think as God thinks or as human beings do? In today's Gospel we see Jesus indicate what type of Messiah he will be - one who will suffer and be rejected. Like him, we are called to take up our cross and follow him. Our faith must lead us to do good works, to love our neighbor in need by providing the necessities of life. Are we content to go to Mass and pray and read good spiritual books and wish our neighbor in need well? Are we simply doing the bare minimum? Are we not called, as James tells us in the second reading, to provide the necessities of life to our neighbors who have no food, clothes? Do we have lonely homebound neighbors? Could you not spare half an hour to visit with them over a cup of coffee? We are not asked to do the impossible, but we are asked to give of ourselves, because faith without works is dead.

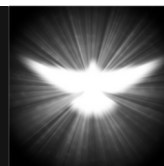
