From the Pastor's Desk,

I have received a few inquiries about the future of the War Memorial plaque on the north side wall of the Mount Carmel parish center. A few weeks ago, Jeffrey Berthiaume, a member of our Property Committee and I, met with City Manager Edward Augustus and the city's Chief Development Officer, Michael Traynor, to discuss the future of the War Memorial. We agreed that in order to protect this historical plaque honoring those from Laurel Hill who gave their lives in service to our country during the two World Wars, the parish would return the plaque to the City. The City Manager indicated that he would discuss the matter with the City Council and a home for the plaque would be designated. We strongly recommended that the plaque be mounted somewhere on Laurel Hill for obvious reasons

This weekend, twenty-three couples are making their Engaged Encounter weekend retreat at the LaSalette Retreat Center in North Attleboro in preparation for their marriages. I will be one of the presenters during the weekend and ask your prayers for these couples that their marriages be long, strong and vibrant, reflective of the love of Christ for them and for all of us. Special Liturgical Spring Plans

******We are seeking volunteers******

Easter is so important to us that we celebrate it for 50 days - up until the Feast of Pentecost on May 20. A week before Pentecost, we also celebrate Mother's Day (May 13) and a month after Pentecost, we celebrate Father's Day (June 17). We have special liturgical plans for each of these days.

On the Feast of Pentecost (May 20) at our 10 am Mass, we plan to have our Prayer of the Faithful recited in several different languages (with translations placed in the pews) to symbolize the moment recorded in sacred scripture (Acts 2:5-6): "Now there were devout Jews from every nation under heaven staying in Jerusalem. At this sound, they gathered in a large crowd, but they were confused because each one heard them speaking in his own language." The Holy Spirit speaks in a language of her own, a spiritual language that transcends normal communication. If you are fluent in a foreign language and would like to participate in the Prayer of the Faithful on that day, please see Msgr. Pedone, Deacon Paul or Deacon Gerry.

On Mother's Day (May 13) and Father's Day (June 17) - again at the 10 am Mass - selected parishioners will give brief testimonials to their mothers and fathers, alive or dead. Again, see Msgr. Pedone, Deacon Paul or Deacon Gerry if you would like to help us bring the glory of Easter and the Spirit to our liturgy by participating in any of these special presentations.

Knights of Columbus
"The Family Fully Alive" Program

Families need to set aside a definite time for formal prayer together in order to have prayer infuse everything they do. Family members must build their life around God rather than fit God into their busy schedule. It is necessary to develop a rhythm because life is shaped by rhythms: the rhythm of heartbeat and breathing, the rhythm of day and night, of meals, of weeks, and so on. The theme for the month of May is:

HOPE

Christian hope is faith in the redemption of Jesus Christ that enables mankind to face the present, even when there are many problems. The one who has hope lives differently. Hopeful people do not get weighed down by pessimism. They choose to counter discouragement by accepting the love of Christ every day through a robust prayer life. They believe "all things are possible" with God (Mt 19:26). They lovingly help their family and friends, realizing that life in its fullness consists in "being for others" even when the other is not affirming or loving in return. Families participate in the life-giving spirit of God through raising children, work, mission, generosity, tenderness and other acts of love. A hopeful family helps each person realize that they live in the world for a purpose—to receive God's love ourselves and to show God's love to others.

Consider these questions:

1. How would our family be different if we did not love at all? How would this affect our sense of hope?
2. In what ways has the Catholic faith and God's love shown us how to love? In what way does the faith shape our hopes?
3. Why is having a relationship with God so important to really living and hoping?
