6th in a Series

Holy, Holy, Holy

In the Book of Revelation, John describes a heavenly liturgy of angels praising God non-stop with the words: "Holy, holy, holy..." So when we sing Holy, Holy, Holy we join the angels in *their* song. Thus, it is we who join the ongoing heavenly liturgy, and in those moments heaven and earth come together to praise God.
