Don't Miss These Symbolisms at Your Next Mass

As Catholics who have gone to countless Masses, we know the order of the different parts of the Mass, and the responses to the priest's prompts come quite instinctively. But most Catholics might miss the symbolisms built in the liturgy because, well, we never knew they were there. Listed here are some of those symbols in words, objects, and gestures.

7th in a Series

The Hosanna

Before the consecration, the congregation sings or says: "Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord, Hosanna in the highest." This comes from Psalm 118 where people cry out Hosanna ("Lord, Grant us salvation!") as they spread leafy branches on the road for the coming of the King. It is what the people were reenacting when Jesus entered Jerusalem before he went to the altar of the Temple. At Mass, we sing or say the same thing as we prepare ourselves for the coming of Christ, the King, whose real presence is about to "come" into the Eucharist on the altar.

Knights of Columbus "The Family Fully Alive" Program

Families need to set aside a definite time for formal prayer together in order to have prayer infuse everything they do. Family members must build their life around God rather than fit God into their busy schedule. It is necessary to develop a rhythm because life is shaped by rhythms: the rhythm of heartbeat and breathing, the rhythm of day and night, of meals, of weeks, and so on. The theme for the month of June is:

WITNESSING TO THE FAITH

Pope Francis, in *Amoris Laetitia*, writes: "A love that fails to grow is at risk. Growth can only occur if we respond to God's grace through constant acts of love, acts of kindness that become ever more frequent, intense, generous, tender and cheerful..." This constant growth in grace leads inevitably to witness in our daily lives. This witness is the primary way to evangelize in our time. The Pope says further in a homily that the family must put comfort and convenience aside "to risk sharing in the suffering of others" who are on the margins. Who are those on the margins? They may be people we never met, the poor, the immigrant and the unborn. They may be people who we know that are lonely and feel isolated. They may be our own family members who are difficult to love because of their personalities. Paradoxically, the margins are not very far from us, but all around us and sometimes even within us.

Consider these questions:

1. How can we as a family better communicate Christ's presence to others in word and action, thereby becoming a "saving community" that shares the love of Christ?
2. What are some ways we as a family can evangelize, and what truths might we express?
3. Why is family such an effective voice for addressing important issues?
