## Pastor's Corner

This weekend Prince Singh and Karen Greenslade will be welcomed into our faith community during a special rite celebrated during the 10 a.m. Mass at St. Bernard's. They have already been baptized but will now formally begin their journey, through the RCIA program, towards full inclusion into the Catholic Faith. We wish them well and promise our prayers and support.

People ask why Jesus was baptized – since He was sinless. John's baptism was a sign of repentance for sin. Jesus identifies with us and takes on all the sin of the world – which He will overcome on our behalf. Our baptism is a sacrament during which the Father calls us to live a worthy life as His children and the Holy Spirit comes to us as our guide and support.

Each Easter we renew our baptismal promises. We renounce sin and Satan and promise to live the life of Christ. Today's celebration should call to mind again the meaning of our baptism and its relation to the baptism of Jesus. God bless you all.

## Stewardship Reflection

Today we see Jesus; the Holy Spirit descends upon Him; and God proclaims, "You are my beloved son; with you I am well pleased."

Each time we make the Sign of the Cross we reinforce our belief in the Trinity, and each time we make the sign we should think of the beauty of the concept. "Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Spirit... now and forever."

St. Therese of Lisieux called prayer "a surge of the heart." Stewardship, of course, involves a conversion of the heart. Each of us must strive for that conversion, and it is most easily accomplished through prayer and liturgy.

**9 Days for Life Novena:** Catholics are encouraged to participate in prayer, penance and pilgrimage, January 17-25. The "9 Days for Life" novena encourages nationwide solidarity in prayer for daily intentions, including for couples experiencing infertility, those mourning the loss of a child through abortion, children in need of adoptive homes, for an end to abortion and use of the death penalty. The initiative is part of the 2014-15 Respect Life Program of the U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) with the theme "Each of Us is a Masterpiece of God's Creation". Each day of the program raises awareness on issues such as domestic violence, post-abortion healing, pornography addiction and end-of-life matters.
