Pastor's Corner

In today's first reading we see Moses' encounter with God who is speaking from a burning bush that is not consumed by the fire. What we wouldn't give to have such a profound encounter with him! However, each time we come to Mass we encounter God in the profound presence of Jesus in the Eucharist, during the celebration of a baptism we experience this also – as we do with all the sacraments. We mustn't always look for the spectacular and dramatic. These sacramental moments are profound moments, holy moments, with God and we should prepare ourselves prayerfully to realize that. We should not grumble at not seeing Him in some sort of vision but rejoice that we can encounter Him through mystery.

We should, as believers, be the fertilizers, the maintainers for a good ground of faith so that others will be drawn to Christ and live out many holy moments and spread the gospel in response. By the witness of our lives we become closer to God and with our fellow pilgrims. Let us during Lent be open to the many ways God wants to work in and through us all. God bless you all.

Stewardship Reflection

You might say that God is trying to get our attention, making an effort to get us to listen to Him and to listen carefully. That is certainly what should be happening during Lent. Today's readings seem to highlight how God tries to reach us, but, of course, the key is that we have to be both prepared to hear the Word and to respond to it.

Each of us should be striving for holiness, for a greater sense of how to serve God and one another through love and stewardship. None of us can fully achieve the yearning to be free from sin. The best way to resist temptation is to acknowledge it and seek God's help in overcoming it.
