## Pastor's Corner

As I mentioned last week, God has no favorites. Justice is for both the good and the bad, the rich and the poor – but there is love and mercy available too. Today's piece from Wisdom is a meditation on the majesty of God and the depth of His love for all His creation. The passage is unique in the Old Testament because of its forceful expression of God's love for all people and things and for its giving a reason for His love.

Zacheus is identified as a sinner in need of God's mercy even though he is well off. "Justification" takes place for him because he is converted by becoming aware of a relationship with God – he is not on God's level, he needs a relationship which trusts in God and not in his own worth. Zacheus seeks out Jesus and is transformed. May we all seek Jesus, and the will of God and true justice. God bless you all.

## Stewardship Reflection

The Zacheus story is a cue for us to recall the importance of humility when it comes to being a good steward, but thanks to the lesson of Zacchaeus we learn even more about how to seek stewardship. Like the tax collector we need to make an effort to seek Jesus; like him we must be humble; we must welcome Jesus into our homes and into our hearts; and finally we need to receive him joyfully.

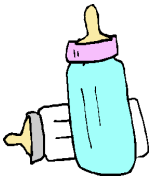
**Social Concerns Meeting:** Thursday, November 3 at 7:00 pm in the parish library at St. Bernard's. All are welcome.
