The season of Advent originated in the 5th century as a fast of forty days commencing after the feast of St. Martin and ending at Christmas. This has changed of course, the duration was reduced to four weeks in the 9th century and now, though still having penitential dimensions, we try to avoid the idea of having a kind of mini Lent. The spirit of the time and its liturgies is still however one of expectation and preparation. We focus on Christmas but also on the second coming of Christ. Despite the Christmas parties etc, we can seek conversion of heart.

With that in mind, Gaudete (Joy) Sunday is seen as a respite when we can relax our fasting and more seriousness disciplines and concentrate on the joy that is coming our way. It is a great day for families and communities. We should then refocus on preparation and be sure to confess any sinfulness in time for Christmas. Let us radiate the joy of the Lord while we wait for His coming glory. God bless you all.

Today, the Third Sunday of Advent, we celebrate *Gaudete* Sunday. *Gaudete* means "rejoice." Although Advent is a season of penitence and preparation, today is always set aside by the Church to relax and rejoice in the Lord.

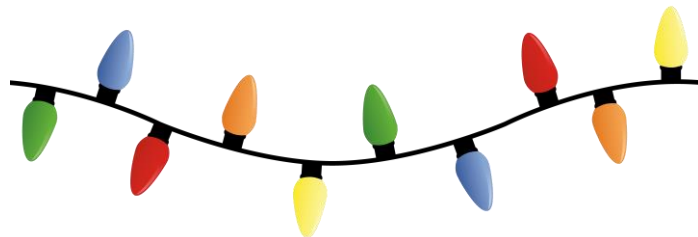
