## Pastor's Corner

Jesus' parable today about the weeds growing alongside the wheat impresses upon us the complexity of human existence. We know that there is both good and bad in each of us and that the good must out. Therefore we should trust in the mercy of God and His kindness if we are to make our way safely along difficult paths. We should follow the path shown us by Jesus.

God has given us the sacraments and in them He remains with us constantly. In particular the Sacrament of Penance and Reconciliation affords us forgiveness and the grace to ward off evil. How often do I confess my sins before the priest – it should be as often as I choose for wrong instead of what is right.

The references to the treasure in the field and the pearl beyond price make sense. We need total commitment to goodness. We need therefore a deeper relationship with Jesus. What a treasure! Once we have chosen for Him we must use His grace to cut ourselves off from paths that lead to destruction.

As you attend Mass next week, think of me as I celebrate Mass in Lourdes to mark my 40<sup>th</sup> year of priesthood. That is where I went the week after my ordination and I have felt the presence Our Lady in my life ever since. I will be praying for you all. Please pray for me. God bless you all.

## Stewardship Reflection

When asked by His disciples to explain the meaning of today's parable, the Lord says in effect that the field in which the crops are placed is the world; the crop can come from good seeds (believers) or bad seeds (those who are non-believers and evil). He also makes it clear though that it is not our role to identify and those who are non-believers. God will do that. At the same time it is not just enough for us to belong to a parish, a community. Our role, our calling, is to love and to serve as good stewards, active participants. God will take care of the rest, and that is our reason for hope.
