Pastor's Corner

With regard to the Gospel today we should remember that Matthew wrote it with the concrete problems of the early church in mind. This Gospel suggests to us that we can rely on interpersonal bonds in order to resolve most of the problems our families and communities experience.

While not considering ourselves judges, it may fall to us to correct others and be "watchmen" to that degree as we see in today's reading from Ezekiel. We have a responsibility for our own souls but also for the good of others as we can acknowledge that at times we are called to help those who have strayed and to bring them back to the right path.

How do we live together? The reflections in the Gospel give practical procedures for dealing with aberrant behavior in various Christian contexts. Jesus, however, stresses that problems can be handled using as few people as possible. Although the Church has its own penal law we hope that use of it will be a last resort after fraternal correction has been found inadequate. Love and charity must rule the day always. God bless you all.

Stewardship Reflection

Most of us know someone whose love is evident by how they treat others and how they live. Loving neighbor is a visible expression of everything that Jesus taught. It is a way of expressing the depth of our faith and our belief that we are Disciples of Christ.

St. Francis de Sales captured all about what this love is and who is your neighbor when he wrote, "Examine your heart often to see if it is such toward your neighbor as you would like his or hers to be toward you in his or her place. This is the touchstone of true reason." It is relatively basic and simple — our neighbor is everyone with whom we have contact and love is what makes it all work.

Note: All catechists or volunteers (18 years and older) working with children under the age of 18 must attend a VIRTUS session, complete a background check, and sign a code of conduct.
