## Pastor's Corner

Today's Solemnity is still called 'Corpus Christi' by most practicing Catholics though a number refer to it as the Feast of the Body and Blood of Christ. It used to be celebrated with great processions etc. and in several parts of the United States and other countries, it still is. Sadly the Eucharist itself is now received by many somewhat mechanically as if it were simply a common ritual at church where all receive whether confessed or not, prepared or not.

When Jesus gave us the Eucharist He instituted a new covenant and sealed it with His blood. We are therefore called to live a life of grace in which we find a share in God's own life. We can have the ability and strength to keep our agreement, or covenant, only through the power of Christ who nourishes us with His own Body and Blood. It is through the Eucharist that Jesus keeps one of His most important promises also: "And behold, I am with you always, to the end of the age" Matt. 28:20. God bless you all.

## Stewardship Reflection

According to the Catechism of the Catholic Church, the Eucharist is "the source and summit of the Christian life. The other sacraments, and indeed all ecclesiastical ministries and works of the apostolate, are bound up with the Eucharist and are oriented toward it. For in the blessed Eucharist is contained the whole spiritual good of the Church, namely Christ himself." Let all good stewards remember this. Stewardship without Eucharist is empty stewardship.
