Pastor's Corner

This is "Guadete" or "Joy" Sunday. God has given us a joy which does not come about through distractions – the distractions of the bright lights and figurines of the Christmas season for instance. It runs deeper. The Father has given us Jesus as our light that dispels all gloom and our model which, if we emulate Him, fulfils us.

The prophet Zephaniah in today's first reading affirms that the Lord is "savior" and is in the midst of His people, whether they perceive His presence or not. St. Paul, in the second reading, tells us that the gift of joy showered upon Christians now permits us to practice the kindness of the early Christians and to be fervent in prayer. John the Baptist had the joy of knowing who he was — that he was not the Messiah. It was his joy to proclaim the One mightier than he. Let us all rejoice at this time. God bless you all.

Stewardship Reflection

We have arrived at Gaudete Sunday (*Gaudete* is the Latin word for "rejoice") this Third Week of Advent, and the Scriptures take on a joyful tone as we continue our preparations for the feast of our Savior's birth.


