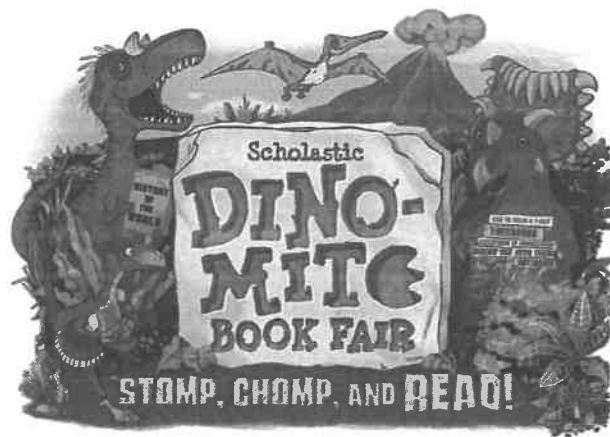

As the school raffle ticket sale begins, remember this important information:

SELLING TICKETS:

1. You cannot begin selling tickets before January 11, 2019, and sales end on February 24, 2019, at midnight.
2. **No one under the age of 18 can purchase a raffle ticket OR WIN ANY PRIZES.**
3. If you are selling tickets to someone out of town or out of state, you cannot mail the entire ticket (it is illegal). The person can send their money to you first, you will complete the ticket stub(s) for them, and mail back the ticket as their receipt for tax deductions.

COMPLETING TICKET STUBS AND COLLECTING THE MONEY:

1. When you sell a ticket, the person **must print clearly** and complete the following information:
First and Last Name, Complete Street Address (city, state, and zip-code), and Phone Number;
School = ICS (Immaculate Conception School) School City = Col. Hgts. (Columbia Heights)
2. **Make sure the ticket stubs are readable and complete.** If stub is not readable, the winning person won't be able to be contacted.
3. **Checks for payment must be made out to I.C.S. (Immaculate Conception School). No exceptions.**


SOLD / UNSOLD / AND LOST TICKETS:

1. When you have all 10 tickets sold, return the ticket stubs and the money to the school office. You can then request additional tickets to sell.
2. If you have trouble selling your tickets, you can sign-up to sell tickets after weekend Masses (Sat. 5:00 pm, Sun. 8:00 am or 10:00 am).
3. Return any unsold tickets to the school office **as soon as possible** to prevent them from being lost. We will then redistribute those tickets to someone who can sell them.
4. If you lose any ticket(s), please report the lost ticket number(s) immediately to the school office.

RETURNING TICKETS:

1. ALL tickets you receive **MUST** be returned (sold or unsold)!
2. Return the ticket stubs and money together in the envelope your tickets were issued in.
3. **Any tickets in your possession which are not returned to the school office MUST be paid for.**

Thank you for selling raffle tickets and helping us to reach our goal of \$9,000. Remember that every dollar we raise stays at Immaculate Conception School. That's a 100% profit!
