## Parents Tab

### The Parent Portal is where you can find your child's class page that has information such as class expectations, messages and daily homework

- In order to get to these community pages please enter the password "pantherpride" and press submit
1. **Master schedule 2017-18** will show when your child will have enrichment teachers teach a variety of classes to your child during the week.
  2. **Class Sites** is where homework can be found on your child's grade page. Several teachers also have reference documents and links to access to help your child with the progress of their education including listing their homework.
  3. **Class supply lists** can be found under this tab
    - Grades TK thru 2<sup>nd</sup> grade communicate with folders that go home each night and are asked to be returned each day. 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> grade teachers also use Class DoJo to communicate with parents.
