A Note Regarding Children's Liturgy of the Word**Growing in Faith***Children's Liturgy*

Children's Liturgy of the Word takes place on Sunday mornings during the 8:30 and 10:30 Masses during the school year. We gather in the chapel and begin with prayer. Modified versions of the Sunday Readings are used to aid and enrich the children's understanding of the Word. Just as our bodies need food to grow, frequent reading of scripture reveals more and more meaning and helps children to open their hearts and grow in their faith.

After the Readings, we have time for a reflection and discussion. The children have an opportunity to ask questions and talk about what God is saying to us. What did we hear as the Gospel was being read? What message does God have for us and how does that apply to us at this stage in our life?

During Advent, each child receives an Advent Calendar to count down the days until Christmas. We talk about the many things we do in preparation for Christmas but the most important is preparing our hearts for Jesus' coming. One way to prepare our hearts is by doing good deeds. During Advent, the children write down their good deeds on a piece of paper and they are kept in a special container until the Feast of the Epiphany. Then, during Gift Preparation of the Feast of the Epiphany, we bring our gifts to the Lord just like the Wise Men many years ago.

Parents are always welcome to join their children and we're always looking for volunteers to help out. Thank you for being great "Witnesses" to Jesus, his teachings, and our faith.

From the Desk of Father Dave

Mass Appeal

The size of the New Prague Area Catholic Community allows us to offer Masses that appeal to people who like different experiences. Mass at St. Wenceslaus, the largest of the three church sites, includes Children's Liturgy of the Word and a variety of music ensembles that aid the prayers of the faithful. St. Scholastica and St. John's great appeal is in their small size in which everyone seemingly knows those present. The small size brings about some natural intimacy. This intimacy can help us feel closer to God. These smaller communities are part of our Catholic Tradition.

Modeled after the Apostles, nearly 2,000 years ago, the first Christians met in small house "churches" and participated in agape meals. Agape is a Greek word meaning deep love of God. There they would share bread and wine celebrating in the name of Jesus. These meals are the forerunners of what we do in Mass today. They not only worshiped together, but they cared for each other's needs. They were the first small faith communities. They often met in secret as there was great risk in being a Christian. Death may be the consequence if they continued to remember Jesus in a special way. Small faith communities have been a way to nurture faith in Jesus and form us as disciples.

I love being a priest for the New Prague Area Catholic Community. We are able to offer a variety of ways of worshiping God that meet the needs of our people. Anytime I preside at Mass, meet, or celebrate with families I feel like I'm walking on sacred ground. Through our smaller Masses, many enter into ownership of the community. One time there was a bit of a mix up at St. John's 10 am Mass. We ended up with eight youth who wanted to serve. We made room for all of them in the sanctuary. During the course of Mass, I observed there were another eight worshipping in the congregation. With only about 110 people in church, I was so proud that my altar servers were so well represented. There will always be a place in my heart for small communities of faith.

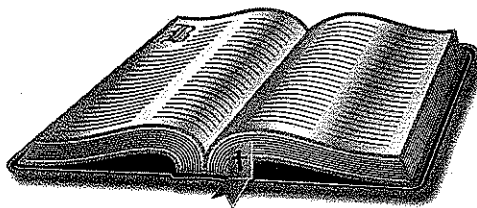

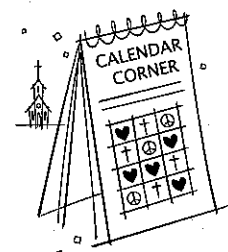
