From the Desk of Mary Higgins**Our Legacy of Faith**

My husband and I decided to take a mini vacation to Mankato in October. We spent some time in area parks and visited the university campus, since we both went to college there. We started out by attending a Sunday morning Mass at the recently built Newman center, since Newman was where we met.

Newman, the Catholic campus ministry, purchased the pews from St. Benedict Church where I was baptized, confirmed, and married. I recognized them as the pews I sat in as a child, the fourth generation of my family to worship there. They were beautifully refinished in a warm walnut that glowed in the sunlight streaming through the windows. It was moving to think that part of a church which is currently being demolished is being used by a new generation of Catholics who will carry on the mission of Christ. I was pleased to see notices of Bible studies, speakers, service and outreach opportunities, and other programs being offered by Newman and to see the almost 100 students actively participating in worship that Sunday morning.

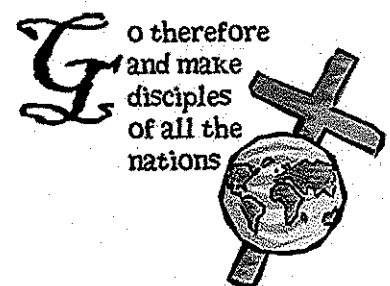
When I recently took my 90-year-old father for a drive in the country, we drove by St. Benedict and I told him that it's coming down. "Well, nothing lasts forever," he said, and it is true that nothing physical humans build on this earth will endure. What will endure are God's love and the kingdom Jesus was sent to proclaim.

The every day saints who built St. Benedict Church have left this earth, as have those who built St. John, St. Scholastica, and St. Wenceslaus, but they did their part to pass on the faith they received from previous generations. Now it's our turn to take up that responsibility. The Feast of All Saints is a fitting time to remember all the faithful who have gone before us, but also to think about those who will come after us. Music is the Key to Good Liturgy

Music is important and has the power to transform our lives. This is especially true of music within the Sunday Mass. Along with the presiding and preaching skills of the priest, music enhances and shapes the prayer life of a parish community. Being so important, the Church requires music at all masses.

This importance is evident through the outstanding musical leadership of Brian Rynda, Rosie Hauer, and the choir at the 8 am Mass every Sunday and the equally outstanding musical direction of Debbie Gregor who directs the choir and coordinates the music for our 8:15 pm Saturday Mass in addition to organizing the music for the 10 am Mass.

Debbie is very busy managing the music for all the Masses, funerals, and weddings at St. Wenceslaus, and directing that site's many choirs and musical groups. Her Sunday morning commitment at that site keeps her busy; so she needs cantors, singers, and musicians from St. Scholastica and St. John the Evangelist to step forward and help in leading the music at the 10 am Sunday Mass. Debbie has found a few people to help from time to time. Deacon Bob has been able to offer his assistance when he is available.

To help Debbie in the planning of music for Sundays, we are going to a common hymnal that will be used at all three church sites. It is the GATHER Hymnal. Greatly respected by liturgical musicians, the hymnal has a wide variety of well known traditional and contemporary hymns. The hymnal also includes all the scriptural readings and responsorial psalms for the three year lectionary used on Sundays. These hymnals are permanent, unlike the missalettes we presently use that are thrown away three times a year. While there is an initial expense to the hymnals, they will pay for themselves within three years, saving us money in the future. Deacon Bob is willing to sit down with anyone who would like to learn more about them. We will begin using the hymnals on the first Sunday of Advent.

For over 25 years, this program has operated through St. Wenceslaus Parish with assistance from the Lutheran churches in New Prague and other churches in Montgomery, Le Center, Le Sueur, and Kilkenny. In October, forms were sent out from the county Department of Human Services. Parents fill out the forms listing their children's ages and **clothing and outerwear gift choices**. The forms are forwarded to a St. Wenceslaus YAC group where they are numbered and names are removed to respect the privacy of the families. Families, individuals, or groups choose a child or family to shop for. The gifts will be distributed to the families on Sat., Dec. 10th at five locations in the county.

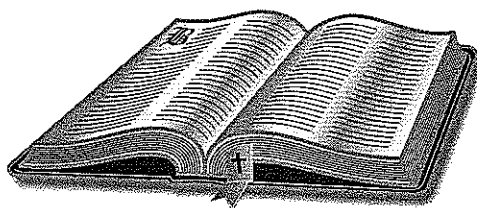

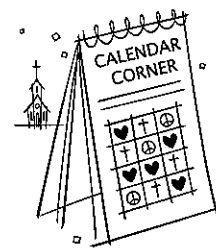
