**A Pro-Life Message****Seek Help before Abortion:**

*"70% of women choosing abortion believe that abortion is morally wrong. They are choosing against their consciences because of some pressure from others or circumstances which make them feel they have no other choice."*

**Life Fund** is an outreach to help women carry their unborn baby or care for their newborn baby with the dignity they both deserve. The Life Fund provides one-time, last resort emergency funding to women in need during their pregnancy and the first year of their child's life. The Life Fund outreach is administered by the Archdiocese of Saint Paul and Minneapolis, in response to the Gospel call *"And whoever receives one child such as this in my name receives me."* **Luke 18:15**

**Post-Abortion Outreach:**

In 1978, our Archdiocese began receiving phone calls from individuals suffering from post-abortion trauma. They realized something had to be done to aid in the healing of these wounded people. It began with the **Marian Project**. It was the first formal outreach to men and women who were emotionally and spiritually devastated by their decision to abort their babies. In 1984, the United States Council of Catholic Bishops (USCCB) formalized this ministry and named it **Project Rachel**.

Project Rachel is a confidential ministry for anyone who desires healing after an abortion. This includes mothers, fathers, grandparents, health care providers, and many others who are affected by the loss of a child to abortion. Abortion is not limited by race, age, or socio-economics.

Project Rachel's mission is *"to provide confidential and compassionate referral services and awareness. Resources are available for spiritual, emotional, and psychological healing to anyone who has been impacted by abortion. Striving to convey God's forgiveness and mercy we hope to restore and empower lives."*

**Rachel's Vineyard** is another outreach program for post-abortive men and women. This program involves a weekend retreat. Their webpage says *"Our mission is to shine the hope and mercy of Christ into the dark night of human pain experienced by parents and families who have lost a child to abortion."* For more information go to [www.rvineyardmn.com](http://www.rvineyardmn.com).

## From the Desk of Father Dave

### Leadership for Life

January 22, 1973, marked the judgment of Roe v. Wade that marked the legalization of abortion throughout the United States. People have been aborting babies since the beginning of time, but in the 1970's, following the sexual revolution, they decided to let the woman choose. Choosing a child out of existence is a tragedy for all involved. This anniversary causes people to rally. I like this day because two of my nephews were both born on the 22nd ten years apart; so I believe it is a day when we can truly believe in respecting life.

I remember 12 years ago I went to the Pro-Life March in Washington DC. So many people were there marching in the relatively mild DC weather. It really warmed my heart to see so many people from all over the country there in support of life. There were many Catholics there, but I thought a fair amount of Protestants joined us as well. We marched together. I was with a priest friend from Pittsburgh and his group. After the March, we had a chance to meet with their legislators who were very open to listening to us. It was a memorable event in my own journey of respecting life.

An area of Church life I would like to expand is liturgy. We are going to have a Lent liturgy planning session on Tuesday, January 31st at 6:30 pm in the house on the property of St. John's Church. The house is east and a little south of the Church. We will look at the readings for Lent. We will look at the impact of the Commitment Drive. Discuss preaching, Prayers of the Faithful, and environment needed for a prayerful Lenten season. More concentration on the Sunday Mass and ministries will come in the months ahead. Be thinking about how we can all participate in the ministries of the Mass. I would like to see leaders for each ministry and try to make people feel more involved. Liturgical ministry is not simply done by a priest. Many should be involved in this life giving action.
