A NOTE FROM MICKEY REDFEARN

As many of you know, I am in formation to be ordained a permanent deacon for the Archdiocese of St. Paul and Minneapolis. On December 9, 2017, God willing, I, and nine other men, will be ordained by Archbishop Hebda at the Cathedral in St. Paul. I share this special event with you in order to request your prayers. I ask everyone to pray for my entire class that we would have open ears and open hearts to listen to the Holy Spirit.

I grew up in Racine, Wisconsin and was very active at St. Paul the Apostle Catholic Church. While in college at the University of Wisconsin-Madison, through St. Paul's, the Catholic Church on campus, I grew even deeper in my relationship with Christ. It was there that I was hired as an intern at the parish and had the opportunity to lead Bible Studies, retreats, and service project trips. I met my wife, Michelle, on a retreat at St. Paul's. We were married at All Saints in Lakeville in 2000 and moved to New Prague in 2002. We have three wonderful sons: Max (14), Noah (12) and Ben (9).

Upon graduation, I desired to continue working in parish ministry, which I still do today. I work as the Stewardship and RCIA Coordinator at St. Bonaventure in Bloomington. Over the years, I have had many people encourage me to become a deacon. As I was encouraged, I opened my ears and my heart to realize that God was in fact calling me to serve the church as a deacon.

I am proud to say that we have had an extensive formation process. When I am ordained I will have completed 4½ years of weekly classes on Tuesday nights and every other Saturday at the University of St. Thomas. We also have the joy of a week-long retreat each summer and a Lenten retreat. Some of my greatest joys have been serving people in internships at St. Joseph's Home for Children, Martin Luther Care Center, and the Ramsey County Jail.

Fall in Love with Mary

The month of May is just around the corner and farmers and gardeners are itching to plant. This month of new growth is dedicated to the Blessed Virgin Mary. We ask that Mary intercede for us. After all, who would know Jesus better than his Mother? Mary can help us in our time of need because she always points us to her Son. Through the rosary we are reminded Mary is near and her Immaculate Heart spreads her great love to us.

This is the 100 year anniversary of the Apparitions at Our Lady of Fatima in Portugal. On May 13, 1917, Mary appeared to three children. She did so monthly until October of that year. I will lead a Pilgrimage to Fatima from September 26 to October 6, 2017. We will also see shrines in Spain and end up at Our Lady of Lourdes in France. This will be a once in a lifetime pilgrimage. There is not a lot of walking and all ages are welcome. Come see what Mary has to show us.

Locally, on May 1st, the New Prague KC Hall is hosting the 2nd Annual Marian Symposium. We begin at 7 pm praying the rosary followed by my talk on Mary in scripture and an overview of her apparitions. I will answer questions about the pilgrimage. Refreshments will be provided. On May 13th, at St. Scholastica, there will be an 8am Mass followed by a procession to and rosary at the Our Lady of Fatima Shrine. Anyone wanting to help with this should contact me. On May 14th, Mother's Day, we will crown Mary at both churches. At the 8 am St. Scholastica Mass, Mary will be crowned and flowers will be brought forward to be planted later at the shrine. Contact Ann Prochaska or Cindy Jirak for more details. At the 10 am Mass at St. John, Mary will be crowned with participation from First Communion and Confirmation students. This is a Youth Ministry event for the whole parish with an activity and refreshments for teens and mothers alike following in the school basement.
