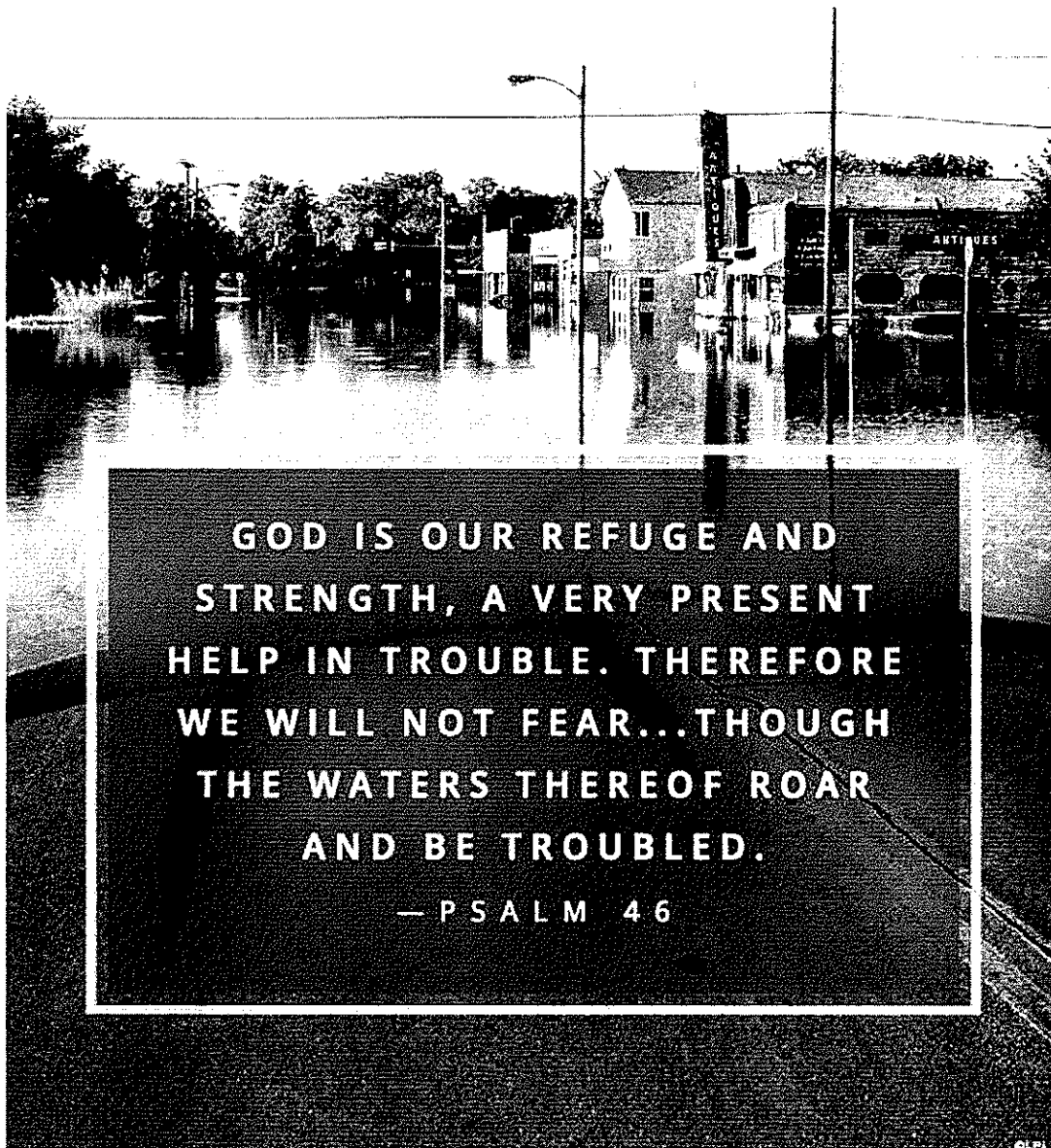

From the Desk of Father Kevin**Defining Ourselves As Intentional Disciples of Jesus Christ In the Here and Now of 2017**

Pope Francis has said: This time we are in is not just an "era of changes", but it is also "a change of eras". These words reflect my experience too! Having been born 68 years ago in 1948, being "Catholic" was very clear ~ back then. EVERYONE knew what to do and what NOT to do. That was true about many things 68 years ago. But it is not the experience now. With the explosion of communication, transportation, and immense advances in all sorts of knowledge, the boundaries and walls of the 1950s that kept life simple and narrowly defined are greatly weakened or even gone. This of course has resulted in much confusion and social DIS-harmony. Welcome to 2017.

As a parish, we are needed to bring into clearer focus who we are and what our parish should be about. To do this we are going back to the ancient roots of our Christian faith. In the first and second centuries, members of the church referred to themselves as "Disciples of Jesus Christ". The epistles of St. Paul and the four gospels do NOT speak of "Catholics" listening to Jesus and continuing the mission of advancing the Kingdom of God. The church community was a gathering of "Jesus' disciples". The gathering was done to celebrate and nurture discipleship. Discipleship was NOT a done deal after baptism. It was a life-long growing and developing process that had, as its center, a growing relationship with a person: the person of Jesus Christ. The teachings of Jesus, the stories about Jesus, the doctrine of the church, the norms and laws of the church all had their role and place, but at the center was each individual and the whole of the church community being in a vital developing relationship with Jesus Christ.

So, first and foremost, we are DISCIPLES of Jesus Christ and the purpose of our faith community is to create an environment where disciples are formed and supported. As disciples, we are in different places on the journey of spiritual growth. We are not all the same, and discipleship grows in different ways according to our needs and the movement of the Holy Spirit among us. This is supposed to be an accepted and a respected "lay of the land" for our parish.

Beginning this fall and into the winter, we plan to develop ways of engaging as many people as possible in small groups. We hope the sharing in these small groups will make clearer how we need to understand ourselves in 2017-18. We have always been "disciples" of Jesus Christ. By next year we hope many of us will have comfort and clarity in defining ourselves as disciples and seeing the life of our parish as a place where disciples of Jesus Christ grow, develop, and celebrate who they are with Him and in Him.

This Should Be Fantastic

I'm of course speaking of our all new Wednesday night Discipleship classes for grades 1-8. This is exciting stuff to be able to gather our young people together so they can learn to have a closer relationship with Jesus. Sure they will get some much needed foundation, but there will also be prayer and deep discussion led by our very talented catechists.

I know some people really miss our WCC program, including me. I put seven years of blood, sweat, and tears into what we accomplished with the help of God. I was privileged to work with great people for so many years. Those of you from the WCC will recognize a number of familiar faces and activities such as the Rosary and Stations of the Cross. I will be there most weeks. I will be working with the creative and energetic Ruth Weinandt to bring you great activities to start each week's class. I will also be making classroom visits and I will even be the celebrant for the opening Mass on September 27th. One of my favorite things to do is preaching to young people.

This new program is really best for our entire parish. We were already using the same textbooks that have a discipleship theme. There will be well thought out lesson plans with places for our catechists to express their own faith. The catechist is trained to be a person who is willing to grow in their faith and share that faith with our young people. They don't have to have a lot of book knowledge to do the job, but they need an open heart to care for our children. Perhaps some of you would open your hearts to this rewarding commitment.

As a parish, we will be working to build a culture of discipleship. The parochial school community is growing in this area. The students that attend the public school are able to experience this discipleship through the work of our Faith Formation professionals and our dedicated volunteers. There are many things brewing in adult formation related to discipleship. We want you to join our Lenten groups to promote the idea that our parish needs to be a community of intentional disciples.

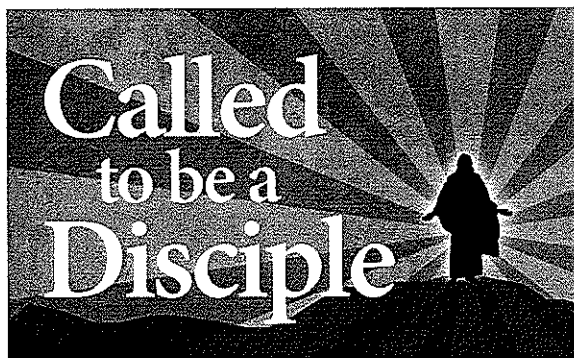
Catholic United Financial Meeting

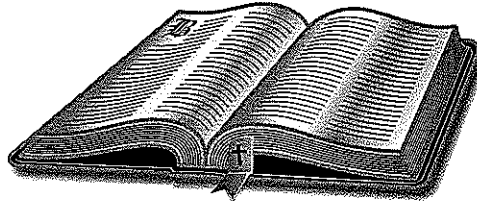
