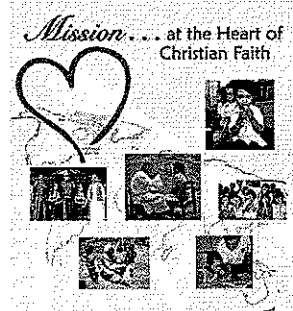

A Word About World Mission Sunday

World Mission Sunday, organized by the **Pontifical Mission Society for the Propagation of the Faith**, is a day set aside for Catholics worldwide to recommit themselves to the Church's missionary activity through prayer and sacrifice. In 2017, **World Mission Sunday** is celebrated on October 22.

This year's theme is, "**Mission-the Heart of Christian faith.**" Chosen by Pope Francis, invites us to understand more than ever that Mission constitutes an essential aspect of the Christian faith; we are sent to our brothers and sisters in order to bear witness of our faith in Christ and to proclaim his Gospel. Beginning with the Second Vatican Council, the Church has worked to restore the essential importance of every baptized person's Missionary dimension.

Annually, **World Mission Sunday** is celebrated on the next-to-last Sunday in October. As described by Pope John Paul II, **World Mission Sunday** is "*an important day in the life of the Church because it teaches how to give: as an offering made to God, in the Eucharistic celebration and for all the missions of the world*".

Every year the needs of the Catholic Church in the Missions grow – as new dioceses are formed, as new seminaries are opened because of the growing number of young men hearing Christ's call to follow Him as priests, as areas devastated by war or natural disaster are rebuilt, and as other areas, long suppressed, are opening up to hear the message of Christ and His Church. That is why the involvement and commitment of Catholics from around the world is so urgently needed. Offerings from Catholics in the United States, on **World Mission Sunday** and throughout the year, are combined with offerings to the **Pontifical Mission Society for the Propagation of the Faith** worldwide.

Mission dioceses ~ about 1,108 at this time ~ receive regular annual assistance from the funds collected. In addition, these mission dioceses submit requests to the Congregation for the Evangelization of Peoples for assistance, among other needs, for catechetical programs, seminaries, the work of Religious Communities, for communication and transportation needs, and for the building of chapels, churches, orphanages and schools. These needs are matched with the funds gathered in each year.

Your ongoing support of the **Pontifical Mission Society for the Propagation of the Faith** is vital to the Missionaries serving dioceses throughout Asia, Africa, parts of Latin America, and Europe, and on the Islands of the Pacific. Your generosity makes it possible for local priests, religious, and catechists to reach out to communities, families, and children in desperate need, bringing the light of Christ to the darkest of circumstances.

From the Desk of Father Dave

Parish Leadership

Fr. Kevin is our pastor and all the major decisions rest with him. He doesn't micro-manage everything and has assembled a staff to join in ministering to the parish and he collaborates with a volunteer network when making decisions. I have been given a leadership role in the Western Catholic Community. I am the first point of contact for all matters. If I feel a matter needs to involve Fr. Kevin, I will inform him. Deacon Bob assists me by working with finances, maintenance, and music. I take care of liturgy, sacraments, pastoral care, and general leadership. Fr. Kevin has recently called our overall parish councils to be more active, so stay tuned for more on his vision.

I meet with Fr. Kevin and Deacon Bob every other week so decisions are not made in isolation. I meet quarterly with a WCC site pastoral council who are comprised of six WCC members who are a sounding board for future plans. I ask them to be my "eyes and ears" within our community. Each serve a three-year term and I am in regular communication with them. These meetings may increase to every other month because I want a stronger pulse on the community. I'm looking for two people to join the council for a three-year term starting in January.

Because of Faith Formation at St. Wenceslaus, confessions are now before the 5 pm Mass on Wednesdays. Starting October 25, 2017, I plan to be in the confessional for about 20 minutes and I will do confessions by appointment on Saturdays and Sundays. In November, I'm going to try office hours on Saturday from 10 am to 2 pm and after Sunday Mass until 1 pm at the St. John's office. The church will be open for prayer. I will be available for confession, questions related to the church and personal life, scheduling Mass Intentions, along with conversations on personal study or scripture. It can also be a place to hang out. If we get large amounts of people, we will use the house or the school. I am working to be more accessible to our community.

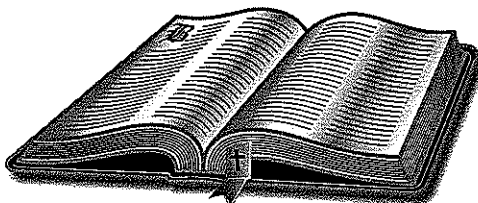

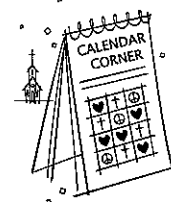
