- About 1.345 billion poor people in developing countries live on \$1.25 a day or less. Almost half the world – over three billion people – live on less than \$2.50 a day. At least 80 percent of people live on less than \$10 a day. (*World Bank*)
- One in eight people throughout the world suffer from chronic undernourishment. About 852 million hungry people live in developing countries, representing 15 percent of those countries' population. Sixteen million people are undernourished in developed countries. (*UN food and Agriculture Organization*)
- More than 80 percent of the world's population lives in countries where income differentials are widening. A Note from a Youth Alive Member

On the third day of Lent, a second grader said to me, "I gave up ice cream for Lent, and I've already failed. I ate some yesterday." I told him it was okay and to just keep trying. "Well, I had some the day before that, too," he added. Again, I said that it was okay and to not give up.

The same is true of God in our own lives; although we give in to temptations over and over again, He never turns His back on us and constantly encourages us to keep trying. I had the opportunity to participate in the Live Stations of the Cross this year, which reminded me of how the Stations perfectly represent this unconditional love God has for us.

Just like Jesus, we all have to carry the crosses in our own lives. We will constantly fall from the burden of sin, yet we must stand back up and keep going. This heaviness keeps us from growing closer to God, so how do we get rid of it? I recently learned the answer to this question at the Senior Retreat a few weeks ago; this can only be done through giving the weight of our sins over to God through the sacrament of Reconciliation.

As we continue in our Lenten journey towards Easter, I encourage everyone to pause in the busyness of everyday life and take a moment to reflect on the crosses you are currently carrying. And, remember, no matter how many times we may fall, God is always waiting for each and every one of us to hand over what weighs us down and to try again.

From the Desk of Deacon Bob

In the Broadway musical, Fiddler on the Roof, there is a song in which Tevye asks his wife, Golde, "Do you love me?" Their marriage had been arranged by their parents, both of them not knowing the other until the day of their wedding. Golde, at first, dismisses his question as foolish. Tevye asks her again, "Do you love me?" She responds with statements like "I bore you 5 children. I've cooked for you. I've cleaned the house for you. I have raised 5 daughters with you. I have suffered and laughed with you for 25 years." After each of these answers, Tevye persists asking her, "Do you love me?" Golde finally admits, "I guess I do love you."

Let us ask the same question as Tevye, but instead pose the question to God. "Do you love me?" The readings for today give to us God's answer. In Ephesians, St. Paul writes, "God, who is rich in mercy, because of the great love he had for us even when we were dead in our transgressions, brought us to life with Christ." In the Gospel, Jesus tells Nicodemus, "God so loved the world that he gave his only Son, so that everyone who believes in him might not perish but might have eternal life." Unlike Golde, who at first hedges in her admission of love for Tevye, God tells us straight out how much God loves us; so much so, that God sent Jesus, his only begotten Son, to bring us everlasting life.

There is a story about the Spanish mystic, St. John of the Cross, who encountered Jesus in a vision. John asks Jesus, "How much do you love me?" Jesus replied, "This much," then spread his arms and died. Were God to ask us in turn, "Do you love me?" how would we respond?

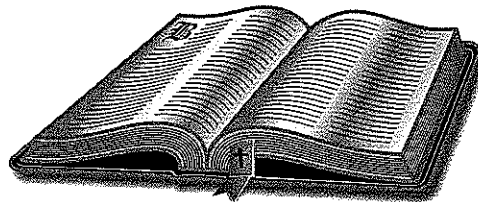

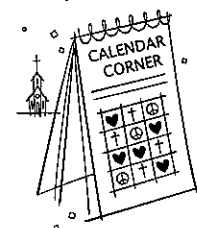
