Trinity B

With the feast of Pentecost last weekend, our Easter season came to an end; the Paschal Candle has returned to its customary spot; the Baptismal Font has been moved back to its place, no longer used as a main focus at the front of the Church during Mass; the solemn sung final Alleluia is put away for another year. We have now returned to the period of green vestments and Ordinary Time, the thirty-three weeks that lead to the Feast of Christ the King and the beginning of Advent. We resume our journey through Ordinary Time with two feastdays, for which we use white vestments; next weekend we celebrate the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of the Lord (known in Latin as Corpus Christi); and this weekend, we celebrate Trinity Sunday.

As Christians, we have a vocation to show God to the world. Throughout history, we have experienced God as a Trinity, as creative Father, redeeming Son, and as supportive and transforming Spirit. Each of these Persons presents us with a unique challenge, as we try to mould ourselves into the likeness of this Trinity. And of course, as a community, we are called to strive for the kind of intimate unity and relationship between our members that the members of the Trinity have. A tall order indeed!

And so today we reflect on our experience of the Trinity of God, and on our opportunities to mirror this image of God to the world around us.
