OSIMO - Veneration of incorrupt body of San Giuseppe da Cupertino

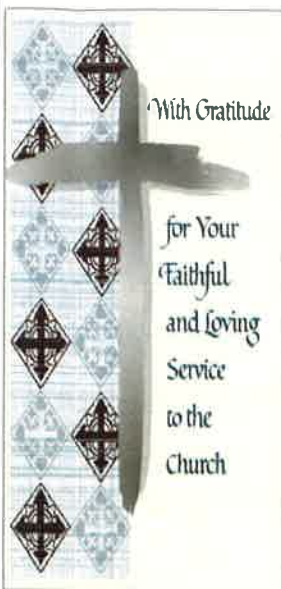
MEDJUGORJE - We will stay until October 3rd. On October 2nd we may have the opportunity to witness The Apparition of Our Lady to the visionaries

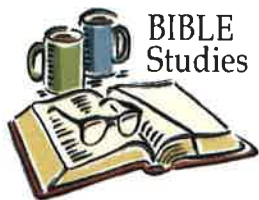


**Catholic Clergy Award
