Sixteenth Sunday of Ordinary Time B

Following on the readings of the past two weeks, where we encountered prophecy and mission, we move on today to the image of the shepherd. The Jewish people had a solid tradition of seeing their kings as shepherds, and in fact their greatest king, King David, had worked as a shepherd.

Jesus is seen in the role of shepherd king, who rules not for his own glory, but out of concern and love for us. He surrenders his life for the flock. And he loves us regardless of our gratitude.

We find ourselves at times in the role of sheep, but perhaps most often in the role of shepherd ourselves. What features of a shepherd are most meaningful to us, and what is the challenge for us in today's readings?
