5) Spirituality and Social Justice – Keith Hebert – The Men’s Mass Group met in the following locations: January 2016, at the outdoor kitchen of Bobby Dupre with Mass celebrated by Father Leger; February 2016 at Valentin Hall Chapel, Mass being celebrated by Father Jerry Mesley; March 2016 at Our Lady of the Oaks Retreat Chapel with Mass celebrated by Father Steve Kimmons and Father Joseph Tedlow. April Mass is set for the 11th, 2016 in the Parish Hall and will be the annual Couples’ Mass for all married couples. Queen of Angels Church purchased and mailed out, with the help of volunteers, a Little Black Lenten Devotional to each parishioner for the sixth year. Deacon Jerome Collins reports that due to recent adjustments, the Adoration Chapel will now be open only from 6:00am to 8:pm.

6) Seniors and Handicapped – Marie LeBlanc – The following meetings and activities have been conducted since January 5, 2016: January 28, 2016: Plans were finalized for the annual “Queen of Hearts” card party which was held on February 3. Attended by over 100 guests, the card party was served a meal prepared by Msgr. DeRouen and committee members. Annette Sebastien reigned as the 2016 Queen and the name of the new “Queen” was pulled from the hat, which just so happened to be a man. Over thirty door prizes were awarded. At the March 2 meeting, planning was completed for the CPR Workshop held on March 30. There were 32 participants educated by FLEX MED Training on different levels of lifesaving CPR skill training, including how to administer adult Hands-Only CPR, adult AED use, child CPR and AED use and infant CPR. They also learned techniques to relieve choking in an adult, child or infant. LHC Group absorbed the \$12 cost per participant and provided healthful snacks along with the Senior Angels Group. The April meeting will be on April 6. Plans will be finished for the April “Step into Spring” event scheduled for April 13. This will include a yoga instructor to teach “Yin” yoga while using a chair. It promotes healthy stretching techniques to increase flexibility and safe mobility. In partnership with our Senior Angels Group, blood pressure checks and other health screenings will take place. A light lunch will be provided, courtesy of the LHC Group. The May activity will include our second annual May Rosary and Coffee Reception on the fifth of this month at 10:00am. All from within the Parish are invited to the Rosary led by Msgr. DeRouen in the Church Hall. Over 100 guests attended this event last year. The end of year luncheon is scheduled for May 11. One of our gracious members, Alice Morrow, has offered to host this event at the Morrow Lodge. The Group accepted. The Senior Angels also helped in the preparation of two “Soup, Salad and Sermon” dinners. They will take the summer off.
