“KC COUNCIL 11270 OCTOBER 2016 NEWSLETTER”

“The monthly membership meeting for September was held on September 6, 2016 at 6:30pm. The meeting began with a meal followed by a Rosary. Financial Secretary, Ken Stephens, reported that the annual Po-Boy Sale held on August 14 raised a net profit of \$5,485.58. Grand Knight thanked all the members for their hard work. Special thanks went out to Clay Saucier for selling over 270 tickets. The Grand Knight discussed using the Po-Boy sale proceeds to help pay for the improvements to the steeple on top of the Church. Msgr. DeRouen hopes to move the speakers for the Church bells, currently in the trees behind the office, to locate them in the steeple. The Knights also discussed the possibility of lighting the steeple. The Council voted to spend up to \$5,000.00 for this project. The Grand Knight also discussed the possibility of purchasing a small book called ‘Cofessions of A Mega Church Pastor’ and to make copies available to the parishioners at Queen of Angels. The Council voted to spend up to \$1,000.00 for this project.

“The October meeting was held on October 4. The Council discussed plans for the annual Tootsie Roll Drive to be held the weekend of October 8-9. Tootsie Rolls are handed out by the Knights at all four Masses, and donations are accepted. The Tootsie Roll Drive is a ation-wide project of the Knights of Columbus. Money raised will be donated to the ARC of St. Landry Parish (80%) and to St. Mary’s Residential Training School (20%). These two organizations work with mentally handicapped adults and do an admirable job. The Council also discussed the Christmas Food Drive which will begin after Thanksgiving. Several schools participate. The Knights will pick up the donated food supplies and deliver them to ICONS for distribution before Christmas. Special thanks were given to Jeremy DeRouen and Super One for their generous contributions. Prayers were offered for brother Knights who are ill, including Harvey Darbonne and Manning Wartelle. The October meal was prepared by Jeremy DeRouen.

The Tootsie Roll Drive was held on October 8-9. Through the generosity of the parishioners of Queen of Angels, the Knights raised \$2,598.00.”
