It is hard for me to believe we will be celebrating our seventh Holy Week together. Gosh, how time flies!

I do want to remind you, with love, that we call this week Holy. We call it holy not only because of the great events we will remember; but we call it holy also because we are to strive to be holy as well. Part of the invitation of this special week is for us to walk with Jesus as closely as possible.

We are invited to come Holy Thursday night at 6:00pm to walk with Jesus who once washed feet, broke bread and shared a cup of wine that He changed into His Body and Blood.

We are invited to come Good Friday at 9:00am for the outdoor Way of the Cross, to come at noon for the beginning of the Novena of the Chaplet of Divine Mercy, and at 3:00 pm for the Good Friday Service wherein we read the Passion of the Lord, venerate the Cross and receive, once again, the Body of the Lord.

We are invited on Holy Saturday to have quiet time for reflection and prayer, thinking about that first Holy Saturday when Mary and the Apostles were so lost without Jesus, thanking God that we know already that we will never be without Jesus.

Then we are invited either Holy Saturday at 8 pm or Easter Sunday at 8:30 am, 10:30 am or 5:15 pm to complete the remembrance of the Paschal Mystery - the Resurrection.
